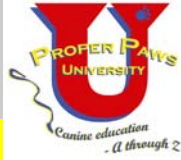

The Bare Bones—Dog Dental Care

Dental Disease is the most commonly diagnosed disorder in veterinary practices in dogs in the United States. Most will have dental disease by the time they are 2 years old. Untreated dental disease can lead to loss of teeth and cause serious disorders like heart or kidney failure.

The best way to prevent your dog from developing dental disease as they get older is to formulate a program when your

pet is young. It is important to take care of your pet’s teeth to keep them healthy and to prevent infections.

Brushing the teeth is the best method that you have for keeping your dog’s teeth bright and shiny and free of disease. Most puppies will allow their teeth to be brushed regularly to remove plaque before it turns into tartar. Another way to help prevent calculus

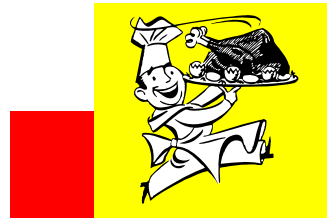
and build up on your dog’s teeth is by using rawhide chews specially formulated for dental care.

Pet Dental kits are available to make teeth brushing easier. Do not use your own toothpaste. The foaming agent in our toothpaste can cause stomach upset in your pet. Even with proper preventive measures, most dogs will eventually need a dental cleaning.

The Dog’s Dish—Turkey Treats

| 2 cups whole wheat flour | 2 eggs |
| 2 cups cooked turkey, cut up | 2 garlic cloves |
| 2 tbl sp brewers yeast | 2 tbl sp fresh parsley, chopped |
| 4 tsp grated cheese | 2 tbl sp vegetable oil |

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Combine turkey, garlic, cheese, parsley and mix well. Beat eggs in a bowl and pour over turkey mixture. Add the flour, yeast and oil. Stir until thoroughly mixed and all ingredients are coated. Drop into small lumps on an ungreased cookie sheet. Bake for 20 minutes or until brown and firm. Store in refrigerator..

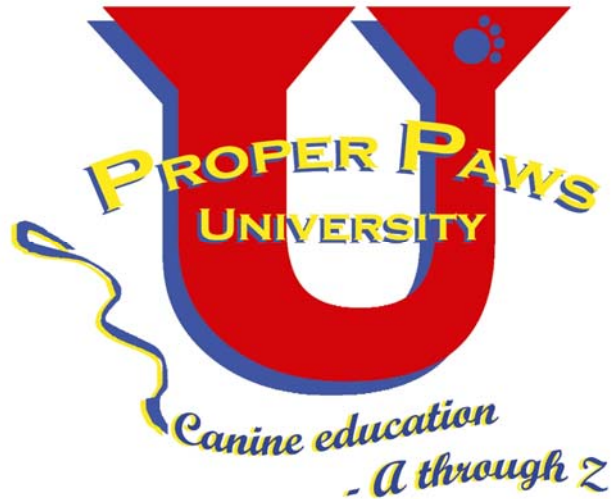
